Why?

When?

What?

An invitation to any (including children) who would like to draw, paint, take photos - or just sit...in company with others...having coffee and cake and listening to some gentle music...

When?

Mornings are often when people have their best energy so 10a.m. – 12noon works well (but any time that suits the host really!).

What it takes!

- > A host or two...the best are parishioners who are artists!
- > Coffee, cake, etc (don't forget children!).
- > If no running water in church then some spare is a good idea.
- > Music
- > Something to put waste paper, pencil shavings, etc. in.

Notes (various).

- 1. Advertise widely.
- 2. Local Art groups will appreciate a personal invitation.
- 3. A basket for donations could be around but subtle...the idea of this event is a *gift* to your community and to encourage people to see the church as theirs!
- 4. With any luck you might even get an *exhibition* in church from the art works (when they're finished!).
