Break Out Room Session	Topic reminders / Questions for discussion
1.	 'Why have chosen to do this role?' 'How do you feel about it?' 'How have you found it so far?'
2.	• Consider the 'Explore – Act – Reflect' cycle relating it to an aspect of the role description from module 4 (which can also be found on the final page of the 'service of commissioning')
3.	 'M' is for 'me' What skills do you bring to the role? How have you / could you use this skill to enable the whole governing board to fulfil its core functions?
4.	 'I' is for 'Impact' In what areas have you already had a positive impact (this could be a small thing or a big thing)? In which of the 8 areas do you feel you could be able to have an impact?
5.	 Vision – what is your school's vision? Provision – what does your school do because of that vision? Impact – how do you know that the vision and what you do because of it is having an impact?
6.	 What is your response to the suggestion that you are 'living out God's transforming presence' in your role as a Foundation Governor? Can you think of ways in which being more aware of this might help you to become more 'effective' in your role? Can you recall, or imagine, moments when it might not be helpful?
7.	 How can we measure whether we are having an impact / whether we are effective in our role? Are there things that you could share with governor colleagues now or in your context, that will encourage them / the whole group (but not in a 'fake' way)? What difference does it make to accept that you have been 'called' into this role by God, recognising that it is a form of ministry?
