





Building on an understanding of Allah to link to Jewish and Christian teachings on creation. Link to festivals - Eid
























Omar asked the imam at his mosque, 'What does Allah want us to do to keep the Earth clean and safe? Why is it important for Muslims to be "green"?

The Qur'an says believers in Allah are those who 'walk on the Earth in humility' (25.63). This means that we should recognise all that Allah has given us as we live on this lovely planet.

Allah gives everyone equally earth, water, air and the growth of food, and so we should walk humbly, as the Qur'an says. Don't be big-headed and think 'We own the Earth.' We don't. God owns the Earth and we are his caretakers.

The Quran says, 'It is He who has appointed you caretakers on the earth ...' (6.165). Muslim character emphasises being moderate and not wasteful. There are seven verses in the Qur'an that link to being a caretaker (khalifah) to the Earth.

The Prophet (PBUH) said, 'The world is beautiful and verdant, and truly God, the Exalted, has made you His stewards in it, and He sees how you acquit yourselves' (Saheeh Muslim).



Omar is a Muslim, He is 5.













The Qur'an says 'O Children of Adam! wear your beautiful apparel at every time and place of prayer: Eat and drink: but don't be wasteful or excessive. Allah doesn't love the wasters." (Qur'an, 7:31). We have a big picnic for Eid in the park and thousands join in. This year we will finish off with everyone picking litter before we go home. We are going to leave the park just perfect.

The Qur'an says believers in Allah are those who "walk on the Earth In humility." (Qur'an, 25:63). This Eid we will give thanks to Allah for the lovely world, and pray for ideas to treat our planet better.

Everyone gets together at Eid, in the park - it makes bad traffic and air pollution. We have all agreed this year to use buses or walk to the celebrations. The mosque is paying for free buses.

New clothes for Eid – that's what usually happens. This year, we are all going to wear some of our favourite clothes, but not buy new ones.


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


Khalifah in 21<sup>st</sup> Century Britain
