

<u>Baha'l Hidden Words</u>

The Hidden Words are a work consisting of short passages in Persian and Arabic revealed by Bahá'u'lláh during His exile in Baghdad, 1857/58. They were translated into English by Shoghi Effendi, Bahá'u'lláh's greatgrandson.

One of the practices of the Baha'i Faith is to read and reflect on the Holy Writings both morning and evening, and these short verses are perfect for this.
