From your Ministry and Mission Support Team: Music and worship and Copyright licences

Jubilate hymns, RESOUND worship and Getty music have all given permission for their music to be used for free in this time. There is a link to an excellent article to explain the copyright situation and what we need licences for in this time of live-streaming and Zoom, here.

You don't need a licence when just using Zoom, because you're not broadcasting the music to a public audience – it's the same as playing music at your home to friends. However, if you broadcast that Zoom session to Facebook or YouTube, you would need CCLI's streaming licence.

PRS is covered by each platform's own licence, so you wouldn't need the LOLM licence for doing that. But you would need a LOLM license if you were to broadcast the Zoom session – or post a catch-up of the Facebook or YouTube video – to your website, as the site would be considered privately owned (by you).
