Preaching online in virtual church

The Revd Ian Paul outlines 7 key points from his own experience – and peer discussions on social media – on his 'Psephizo' blog.

- **1. Length:** your audience may be at home or elsewhere, and there are distractions! Keep it concise, consider presenting it in segments
- 2. Structure: simplify
- 3. Expression, attitude and tone: smile, vary expression and tone, conversational
- **4. Script:** be disciplined, use bullet points as prompts, learn by heart if you can, or use a teleprompter app
- **5. Rhetoric:** repetition, lists of 3, alliteration, aphorisms, avoid Christian jargon
- **6. Appearance:** sitting up or standing, well groomed, well lit, eye to eye
- **7. Feedback:** watch yourself afterwards, get honest comment from those you trust, and evaluate for next time
